Project Overview

The initial study area covers several 14-digit hydrologic units from Conetoe Creek down to Chicod Creek, all draining to the Tar River. This area was chosen because of existing water quality and aquatic habitat degradation issues, as well as important habitat values which are present. Waterbodies within this area are designated as Nutrient Sensitive Waters. Chicod Creek is also 303(d) listed as an impaired waterbody. The watershed area contains the Towns of Princeville and Tarboro and the City of Greenville.

Project Schedule

The initial watershed characterization was completed in February 2004. Phase II and III was completed in the fall of 2007.
